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3. Conferences and seminars on topical business crime issues:

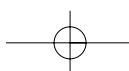
- Priority access and discounted membership rates (where relevant) to all SBCC events.

 - Opportunity to engage with a variety of business disciplines.
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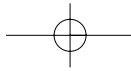
4. Networking
